RESOLUTION TO CONSOLIDATE PRECINCTS FOR THE CITY PRIMARY
TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2025**

WHEREAS, the City of Lansing anticipates a low voter turnout for the City General Election on November 4, 2025; and

WHEREAS, consolidating precincts would save funds by reducing the number of election inspectors, lowering programming expenses, and reducing equipment delivery costs; and

WHEREAS, MCL 168.659 allows for the City Election Commission to consolidate two or more precincts in local elections, provided the new consolidated precinct does not exceed 5,000 active registered voters; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following precincts be consolidated for the November 4, 2025 City General Election:

3 and 4 voting at Post Oak School
9 and 10 voting at Potter Park Zoo
13 and 14 voting at Bethlehem Lutheran Church
15 and 16 voting at Parker Memorial Baptist Church
17 and 20 voting at Parker Memorial Baptist Church
22 and 27 voting at Dr. Halik Professional Development Center
23 and 24 voting at Dwight Rich School
25 and 26 voting at Tabernacle of David Church
37 and 38 voting at Letts Community Center
39 and 40 voting at Hope Christian Ministries Church

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other precincts will not be consolidated for the November 4, 2025 City General Election.
