RESOLUTION – Issuance of Sewage Disposal System Revenue Bonds for 2026 Improvements
Mc. McPherson noted that this is brought every year as part of the wet weather control plan. The resolution provides for next improvements for Tecumseh River Road Pump Station and sewer project on Cherry, Kalamazoo and Pine Streets. Cost is not expected to be beyond \$40 million, and they received bids last Wednesday in the \$37 million range, and will get the final number next week.

Councilmember Garza mentioned doing the math that is leaving \$700,000 do they anticipate it affecting any projects. Ms. McPherson answered no, they plan it out and some come in at more some at less, so it works out, and they budget every year.
