RESOLUTION – Fireworks Display by Lansing Lugnuts/Roger Bonney at Cooley Law School Stadium at 505 E. Michigan Avenue on various dates

Council Member Washington introduced the resolution for a fireworks display license for Lansing Lugnuts/Roger Bonney for a public display of fireworks at Cooley Law School. The first show is scheduled for April 8th, so Council will also be voting tonight.

Council Member Wood asked about rain dates. Mr. Hault clarified that the dates listed accounted for 17 shows. They have paid for the first 10, and if those are rain outs they will move into the next dates as rain dates. Once they get past 10 they will pay for the additional.

It was noted the application was not signed off by Law or the Fire Marshall. Council Staff pulled up the application from the Clerk, and the latest version did include the sign off from the Fire Marshall. Mr. Abood reviewed the Certificate of Insurance and signed it however, requested an updated certificate because the dates listed on the certificate spoke to “test fires” not the official event dates.

Mr. Hault contacted the applicant, Mr. Bonney who emailed the updated certificate to staff, who in turn provided to the City Attorney for the final approval at Council.
