RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANSING

WHEREAS, The Lansing Office of Emergency Management receives Federally-funded grant dollars, Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), to pay for 35.69% of the program Coordinators Salary and Fringe benefits; and

WHEREAS, The EMPG grant is an annual hand down grant to the State of Michigan and is awarded to Emergency Management programs within the State of Michigan annually; and

WHEREAS, The EMPG grant is designed to provide federal EMPG funds to the sub grantee for the development and maintenance of an emergency management program capable of protecting life, property, and vital infrastructure in time of disaster or emergency; and

WHEREAS, The EMPG awards \$65,341.00 for the duration of twelve (12) months

WHEREAS, The State of Michigan award of \$65,341.00 requires a 50% cost match (cash or in-kind) local match, which is covered through budgetary funding; and

WHEREAS, The EMPG grant will fund a percentage of the compensation of the Emergency Management program coordinator's salary and fringe benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Lansing City Council approves acceptance of the EMPG grant in the total amount of \$65,341.00 for the grant period beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017 to fund 35.69% of the Emergency Management program coordinators salary; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, The Administration is authorized to create appropriate accounts and to make the necessary operating transfers for the expenditure and control of the balance of the grant funds.

**Subject: Recommendation of Sole Source Contractor
Flygt Pump for Raw Sewage Pump Station**

I recommend that Kennedy Industries (Kennedy) be awarded the work, as a sole-source supplier, to provide a Flygt Submersible vertical dry-pit pump for \$44,119.00. This pump will replace an existing pump that has failed in the Raw Sewage Pump Station. Kennedy's quotation is attached,

The Raw Sewage Pump Station, located at the Lansing Wastewater Treatment Plant, services an area that lies primarily to the west and south of the plant. A small pump is used for low flow operation, and 3 larger pumps are available for high flow conditions. During wet weather events, rainwater infiltration causes the flow to the pump station to spike, and all 3 large pumps in the station run, pushing over 6,000 gallons per minute. It is important to get the failed pump replaced with a reliable, long-lasting pump.

There are several reasons why we would like to sole-source Flygt as the pump manufacturer.

1. Service by the pump supplier, Kennedy Industries, has been very good and they are highly responsive.
2. The operators are familiar with Flygt pumps and they have been reliable in the wastewater treatment and collection system.
3. Operation and maintenance of the pumps will be similar to the other Flygt pumps that the operators already maintain.
4. The Flygt pump uses the source water for cooling. Other pumps use a potable water source for cooling, which increases the operating cost. Also, piping must be extended to the pump and maintained. Maintenance on the pump seals requires disconnecting and reconnecting the water source.
