MOTION BY COUNCIL MEMBER HUSSAIN TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 25, 2021 AS PRESENTED. MOTION CARRIED 2-0.

Discussion/Action

Council Member Spadafore moved item C to the first discussion topic.

RESOLUTION – Liquor License; Lorenzo's LLC for a SDM and Class C license, Sunday sales (PM), topless, extended hours, dance, entertainment, and outdoor service permits at 1247 Center Street.

Council Member Spadafore asked who was present for the liquor license. Amanda Dernovshek introduced herself as an attorney with Foster, Swift, Collins & Smith and for the applicant Adam Brewer. Council Member Spadafore asked if this is the old Spiral location and Ms. Dernovshek confirmed adding that this was a liquor and cabaret license request, and all applications were submitted and that it is planned to continue with the same operations as in liquor sales and dancing. Council Member Hussain asked Ms. Hagen if she could find out who's signature was

in for Planning/Zoning as it was difficult to read. Ms. Hagen said she would verify with Brian McGrain but believed it was Susan Stachowiak.

RESOLUTION – Appointment; Kris Young as the 4th Ward member of the Board of Public Service for a term to expire June 30, 2024
