Lansing, Michigan, be and is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall be null and void and of no
effect.

inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed in their entirety and shall be null and
void and of no effect.

Section 3. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared to be
invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof
other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 4. This ordinance repeal shall take effect on the 30th day after enactment, unless
given immediate effect by City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LANSING, MICHIGAN, TO AMEND CHAPTER 404 OF THE LANSING CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY ADDING SECTION 404.12 TO PROVIDE FOR THE DECLARATION OF SNOW EMERGENCY DURING AND AFTER WEATHER EVENTS THAT WILL REQUIRE SALTING AND/OR PLOWING OF ROADWAYS; TO PROVIDE FOR HOW NOTICE SHALL BE GIVEN FOR SNOW EMERGENCIES; TO PROHIBIT PARKING IN ROADWAYS DURING DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCIES; AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR PERSONS PARKING ON THE ROADWAYS DURING DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCIES.

THE CITY OF LANSING ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 404 of the Lansing Code of Ordinances of the City of Lansing is hereby amended to add Section 404.12 as follows:

404.12 – PARKING PROHIBITED DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES

WHEN WEATHER EVENTS REQUIRE SALTING AND/OR PLOWING OF SNOW AND ICE FROM THE ROADWAYS TO ENSURE SAFE TRAVEL, SNOW EMERGENCIES WILL BE DECLARED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. DURING DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCIES, NO PERSON MAY PARK ANY VEHICLE, OR LEAVE ANY VEHICLE PARKED, UPON ROADWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF LANSING DESCRIBED BY THIS SECTION.

(A) DECLARATION AND PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT OF SNOW EMERGENCY.

THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE WILL DECLARE A SNOW EMERGENCY WHENEVER A WEATHER EVENT, OR ANTICIPATED WEATHER EVENT, WILL

1 REQUIRE SALTING AND/OR PLOWING OF SNOW AND ICE FROM THE ROADWAYS IN
2 THE CITY. THE CHIEF OF POLICE SHALL CAUSE EACH DECLARATION OF A SNOW
3 EMERGENCY TO BE PUBLICLY ANNOUNCED BY MEANS OF TELEVISION AND
4 RADIO BROADCASTS AND/OR TELECASTS FROM STATIONS WITH A NORMAL
5 OPERATING RANGE COVERING THE CITY, INCLUDING CABLE TELEVISION
6 FRANCHISEES OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY. THE CHIEF OF POLICE MAY CAUSE
7 SUCH DECLARATION TO BE FURTHER MADE IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL
8 CIRCULATION IF NECESSARY AND FEASIBLE.

9 (B) THREE LEVELS OF SNOW EMERGENCY.

10 THERE SHALL BE THREE LEVELS OF SNOW EMERGENCY WHICH MAY BE
11 DECLARED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, DEFINED AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

12 (I) LEVEL 1 – DURING A LEVEL 1 SNOW EMERGENCY, PARKING WILL BE
13 PROHIBITED BETWEEN 2-6 AM IN THE DOWNTOWN, AND DURING ALL
14 HOURS ON SELECT ARTERIAL, NEIGHBORHOOD, AND TRANSIT
15 ROUTE ROADWAYS, WHICH WILL BE NAMED WHEN THE SNOW
16 EMERGENCY IS DECLARED.

17 (II) LEVEL 2 – DURING A LEVEL 2 SNOW EMERGENCY, PARKING WILL BE
18 PROHIBITED BETWEEN 2-6 AM IN THE DOWNTOWN, AND DURING ALL
19 HOURS IN THE REST OF THE CITY.

20 (III) LEVEL 3 – DURING A LEVEL 3 SNOW EMERGENCY, PARKING WILL BE
21 PROHIBITED 24 HOURS A DAY THROUGHOUT THE CITY.

22 (C) TERMINATION OF SNOW EMERGENCY AND PARKING PROHIBITION.

1 ONCE IN EFFECT, THE PROHIBITION ON PARKING IN ROADWAYS SHALL REMAIN
2 IN EFFECT UNTIL TERMINATED BY ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE, IN
3 COORDINATION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, BY THE SAME MEANS
4 SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (A). ADDITIONALLY, A ROADWAY THAT HAS BEEN
5 PLOWED OF SNOW AND ICE, FOR THE ENTIRETY OF THE BLOCK ON BOTH SIDES,
6 AFTER DECLARATION AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF A SNOW EMERGENCY, SHALL
7 BECOME EXCLUDED FROM THE PROHIBITION ON PARKING:

8 (C) VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

9 ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION WILL BE TICKETED FOR A PARKING
10 VIOLATION AND FINED CONSISTENT WITH THIS CHAPTER. IN ANY PROCEEDING
11 FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, PROOF THAT A PARTICULAR INDIVIDUAL
12 WAS THE REGISTERED OWNER OF A PARTICULAR VEHICLE AT THE TIME OF THE
13 VIOLATION SHALL CREATE THE PRESUMPTION THAT THE REGISTERED OWNER
14 WAS THE PERSON WHO PARKED THE VEHICLE IN VIOLATION.

15 (D) TOWING AND IMPOUNDMENT OF VEHICLES PARKED IN ROADWAY DURING
16 SNOW EMERGENCY.

17 ANY VEHICLE PARKED OR LEFT ON ANY CITY ROADWAY IN VIOLATION OF THIS
18 SECTION CONSTITUTES A PUBLIC HAZARD AND AN OBSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC
19 AND MAY BE TOWED AND IMPOUNDED IMMEDIATELY. NO PERSON MAY
20 RECOVER ANY IMPOUNDED VEHICLE WITHOUT FIRST PAYING THE COST OF
21 REMOVAL AND STORAGE, NOTWITHSTANDING, AND APART FROM, ANY FINE
22 WHICH MAY ALSO BE IMPOSED FOR VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER.

1 Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions or rules, parts of ordinances, resolutions or rules
2 inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed in their entirety and shall be null and
3 void and of no effect.

4 Section 3. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared to be invalid,
5 the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the
6 part so declared to be invalid.

7 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect on March 1, 2020, unless given immediate effect
8 by City Council, and pursuant to Section 3-307 of the City Charter, this Chapter shall expire
9 December 31, 2028.

WHEREAS, the Engineering Division of the Public Service Department Has conducted a Traffic Signal Removal/Upgrade Study at the intersection of Cesar E. Chavez Avenue and High Street to determine if the traffic volumes currently meet the Michigan Manual of Uniform of Traffic Control Devices (MMUTCD) Traffic Signal Warrants;

WHEREAS, the Traffic Signal Removal/Upgrade Study was conducted as part of an overall evaluation of the Traffic Signal System to determine if the signal should be modernized or removed as a result of recent traffic volume reductions;

WHEREAS, the Engineering Division's study determined the existing traffic volumes at the intersection of Cesar E. Chavez Avenue and High Street do not meet current MMUTCD Traffic Signal Warrants;

WHEREAS, field observations determined the placement of the traffic signal in flash on Cesar E. Chavez Avenue at High Street would improve traffic operations at the intersection;

WHEREAS, The Engineering Division has received no complaints from businesses or residents since the signal was placed in flash on May 6, 2019;

WHEREAS, there have been no reported accidents at this intersection since the signal was placed in flash;

WHEREAS, Based on the observations and no public concern, the City of Lansing's Transportation Section recommends the permanent removal of the traffic signals with stop signs installed on High Street requiring all High Street traffic to stop prior to entering the intersection at Cesar E. Chavez Avenue;

WHEREAS, the Public Service Board has reviewed and voted unanimously to recommend the removal of traffic signals and the installation of stop signs on High Street at the Cesar E Chavez Avenue and High Street intersection;

WHEREAS, the draft minutes for the Public Service Board containing their review of this matter are on file with the City Clerk's office;

WHEREAS, the City of Lansing received its first funding allocations in the amount of \$1,203,250 for CDBG-CV to assist small businesses, provide technical assistance to businesses/microenterprises and homelessness prevention for persons 51%-80% of AMI of those impacted by the coronavirus and \$608,455 in ESG-CV to assist the homeless or those receiving homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of COVID19; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lansing has received a second funding allocation in the amount of \$1,282,028 for ESG-CV2 to assist the homeless or those receiving homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of COVID19; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to submit another substantial amendment to its FY 2019 Annual Action Plan in order to receive these CARES ACT (COVID19) funds of ESG-CV 2; and

WHEREAS, there are several flexibilities and regulations relaxed to make it easier and quicker to receive the funds to address the coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lansing has posted the substantial amendment information on its website for public review and comments; and

WHEREAS, Federal regulations require the City to make certain certifications and assurances to HUD as a part of the City's application and Annual Action Plan substantial amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lansing adopts the Annual Action Plan substantial amendment for the City of Lansing's second allocation of CARES ACT Funds for ESG-CV2 that includes activities to prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus pandemic; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, as the City's Chief Executive Officer, or his designee is hereby authorized to sign the Annual Action Plan and application for FY 2019 substantial amendment, including all understandings, assurances and certifications contained therein, and to submit the grant application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Mayor or his designee is authorized, as the official representative of the City of Lansing, to set-up budget line items, provide any and all information, to act in connection with the Annual Action Plan application and to execute all agreements, contracts and legal documents, including the agreement between the City and the Department of Housing and Urban Development, to secure ESG-CV2 funding and implement the Annual Action Plan programs.

Under the CARES ACT, there are additional regulatory flexibility/waivers for ESG-CV funds and the City of Lansing must prepare a substantial amendment to its FY 2019 Annual Action Plan. Citizen Participation and Consultation is not applicable to ESG-CV funding but, how the allocations will be used must be published on the City of Lansing's website.

City of Lansing ESG-CV Summary Plan

The City of Lansing, MI Emergency Solutions Grant – COVID-19 (ESG-CV) plan is funded by the *Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES ACT)* (Public Law 116-131) to prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus. To address housing, economic development and homelessness activities during this coronavirus pandemic, the City of Lansing will use a total of \$1,890,483 of ESG-CV funds (Round 1 allocation \$608,455 + Round 2 allocation \$1,282,028) to provide rapid rehousing, homeless prevention assistance, emergency shelter, street outreach, HMIS, and supportive human services for people with special needs, people who are homeless and those at risk of becoming homeless.

The City of Lansing Economic Development and Planning (EDP) and the Human Relations and Community Services (HRCS) Departments work closely with the Continuum of Care (CoC), the Capital Region Housing Collaborative (CRHC), to address homelessness in the general population as well as among veterans through its strategic plan. The CoC's Strategic Plan aligns with the City of Lansing's Consolidated/Annual Action Plan. A centralized intake and assessment system, known as the HARA, acts as a focal point to obtain assistance and resources to connect with community agencies to address chronic homelessness in the community.

COVID Needs Addressed by ESG-CV funding – COVID screenings, personal protective equipment (PPE), referrals to COVID specific health resources (testing, isolation, contagion centers), safe and de-congregated homeless shelter, non-congregate sheltering, additional sanitation protocols, food, and personal needs. Enhanced street outreach, low barrier overflow sheltering geared to street homeless, basic survival needs, rapid rehousing, homelessness prevention, collaborative planning and systems changes necessary for services provision due to the effects of COVID.

CARES ESG-CV Funding - \$1,890,483 (\$608,455 (first allocation) + \$1,282,028 (second allocation)

Description - The FY2019 CARES Act ESG-CV funding for the City of Lansing will be provided for street outreach activities, emergency shelter, rapid rehousing, homeless prevention, HMIS, and administration. Funds will be used to cover the cost of staffing, maintenance, repairs, operations, food, supplies, PPE, insurance, utilities and furnishings in shelter facilities and outreach; for non-congregate sheltering or overflow low barrier shelter, including hoteling; rental assistance, computer hardware or software, and administration costs necessary to address the pandemic.

Target Date – March 1, 2020 to September 30, 2022

The number and type of families that will benefit from the proposed activities:

ESG-CV Emergency Shelter and non-congregate shelter persons assisted: - \$917,885; 789 (415 individuals and 110 families with 374 people)

ESG-CV Homelessness Prevention: \$430,627; 75 families with 225 people; (Other homelessness prevention is funded by other sources)

ESG-CV Rapid Rehousing: \$103,825; 22 families with 66 people; (RRH is also funded by other sources)

Other: Street outreach: \$199,098; 650 people (480 individuals and 55 families with 170 people). Alongside traditional ESG allocations, these funds will be used for Personal Protective Equipment, hygiene and COVID screenings and referral to COVID resources.

Location Description – Shelters, non-congregate sheltering, and low-barrier street outreach shelter are located in key areas of Lansing and East Lansing, including near food distribution sites. Street Outreach is conducted throughout Ingham County, including specialized youth outreach and shelter, and coordinated services with service providers in the tri-county area.

Planned Activities – Street Outreach, Emergency Shelter, Rapid Re-Housing, Homeless Prevention and Admin (\$189,048).

The CARES Act ESG-CV funds will allow the local CoC to prevent, prepare for and mitigate risks of COVID-19 among the homeless population in Ingham County. Activities include de-congregating shelters to create social distancing and enhance safety, moving “high-risk for COVID-19” people to non-congregate settings, and establishing a low barrier shelter for street homeless who cannot be served in other shelters. The ESG-CV funds will provide enhanced street outreach for encampments, PPE, room dividers, COVID screenings, and referral to COVID health-related services such as testing, isolation and contagion centers. The CoC has engaged in ongoing consultation with the Emergency Operations Centers, both City and County, FEMA, local public health, united way, and a host of other local human service providers. The CoC shelters are holding semi-monthly meetings to share best practices to screen and mitigate the spread of infection, access PPE and supplies, share staffing, and coordinate services and planning to address identified needs and services gaps. A fall/winter Shelter response plan is in the development stages. The CoC has been preparing for the end of the eviction moratorium by creating a coordinated homeless prevention community response including fliers, landlord resource guide, and a workflow to guide people to the correct agency, in cooperation with legal services, homeless providers, and rental assistance programs. The City of Lansing 54A District Court has opened an Eviction Diversion Program to assist tenants facing eviction. A shared screening tool is used by local agencies with the Coordinated Entry and 211 as points of entry to prevent homelessness and rapidly rehouse sheltered guests. HMIS enhancements are increasing efficiencies and safety with electronic referrals to prevention, Eviction Diversion and rapid rehousing programs. Computer stations and hotspots are being developed for those in need. Enhanced case management will add a liaison position to work with mainstream employment and educational agencies to resolve barriers for homeless persons using these systems. Child care funds will allow people to participate in employment or educational training.

PENALTY HEARING ORDER

Under MCL 436.1903(1), the Commission shall hold a Penalty Hearing and impose a suspension or revocation of the 2020 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) held by Mikho's Party Store Inc, d/b/a Mikho's Party Store ("licensee") at the above-noted address, as the licensee was found liable for three (3) or more separate violations of MCL 436.1801(2) that occurred on different occasions within a 24-month period. Those violations occurred on December 14, 2017, April 25, 2019, and May 20, 2019.

The penalty hearing was held on August 25, 2020 and Attorney Michael Brown represented the licensee. Also present at the hearing was licensee stockholder, Sarmad Mikho.

After reviewing the record of the three (3) violations within a consecutive 24-month period which necessitated the penalty hearing, hearing arguments from Attorney Brown and Mr. Mikho, and review of the MLCC file, the Commission finds that revocation of the licenses is not necessary in this matter. However, the Commission further finds that a suspension of the licenses is required, and the licensee has demonstrated reasons to order a suspension in this matter for the following reasons:

- The Commission finds that the licenses were originally issued to the licensee at this location on October 2, 2009.
- The Commission finds that in the first two (2) occurrences, the clerk(s) sold to each decoy and failed to request identification of the 17 and 18-year-old minor(s) purchasing alcohol. The Commission has *extreme* concerns as to the very young ages of the minors in these incidents.
- The Commission finds that in the third occurrence, the clerk sold alcohol to the 20-year-old minor after requesting identification.
- The Commission finds that the licensee has demonstrated the licensee stockholder, Sarmad Mikho, and his one remaining employee, Lee Kadhem, successfully completed Michigan Alcohol Server/Seller Training in June of 2019, which is after the third sale-to-minor violation.
- Commission records reflect that in addition to the violations addressed in the penalty hearing proceedings, the licensee was found responsible for an additional sale to minor violation that occurred on April 10, 2012, and the clerk sold alcohol to a 19-year-old minor after requesting identification.
- The Commission finds that the licensee has passed a total of ten (10) controlled-buy operations for alcohol conducted by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (2) and the Lansing Police Department (8).
- The Commission finds that the licensee has entered into a purchase agreement to sell the SDD license to L.M. C-Store, Inc., and a request to transfer ownership of the subject SDD license is pending final Commission consideration. (Request ID No. 2002-02607).

Under MCL 436.1903(1), the Commission shall issue a penalty of suspension or revocation in this matter. The Commission finds that a one (1) month consecutive day suspension is warranted for the reasons stated on the record; to be served beginning on Friday, August 28, 2020 through Sunday, September 27, 2020; with the licenses to be returned on Monday, September 28, 2020.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The 2020 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) held by Mikho's Party Store Inc, d/b/a Mikho's Party Store at the subject address are SUSPENDED for a one (1) month consecutive day period; to be served beginning on Friday, August 28, 2020 through Sunday, September 27, 2020; with the licenses to be returned on Monday, September 28, 2020.
- B. The suspension is to run consecutively and not concurrently with any other suspension ordered by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission for this licensee.

(excerpt)

5-505 CONFLICT OF INTEREST

.1 At least ten (10) days prior to the first of any of the events set forth in (A), (B), (C), (D), and (E) below, a City officer or employee who may derive any income or benefit, directly or indirectly, from a contract with the City or from any City action, shall file an affidavit with the City Clerk detailing such income and benefit to be derived:

(A) The bidding of the contract;

(B) The negotiation of the contract;

(C) The solicitation of the contract;

(D) The entry into the contract;

(E) Any City action by which the City officer or employee may derive any income or benefit, directly or indirectly.

The above provisions shall not apply to individual or collective bargaining agreements pursuant to which a City officer or employee directly or indirectly receives income or benefits in the form of official remuneration as an officer or employee, or any City action pursuant to which a City officer or employee directly or indirectly receives income or benefit as a member of the public at large or any class thereof. At the first regularly scheduled City Council meeting following the filing of an affidavit pursuant to this section, the City Clerk shall notify the City Council of such filing. In particular cases and for good cause shown, the Board may waive the ten (10) day prior notice requirement contained herein.

.2 An officer or employee who has any other conflict between a personal interest and the public interest as defined by State law, this Charter, or ordinance shall fully disclose to the City Attorney the nature of the conflict.

.3 Except as provided by law, no elective officer, appointee or employee of the City may participate in, vote upon or act upon any matter if a conflict exists.
