Agencies highlighted in green scored above the threshold approved, those with an asterisk required special attention and those who did not meet the threshold are highlight in red.

The HRCS Advisory Board proceeded with reviewing those agencies with an asterisk. There was brief discussion each agency on the scoring and comments with a consensus reached on the recommended funding. There was a decision made to receive a blanket motion once all agencies were reviewed.
